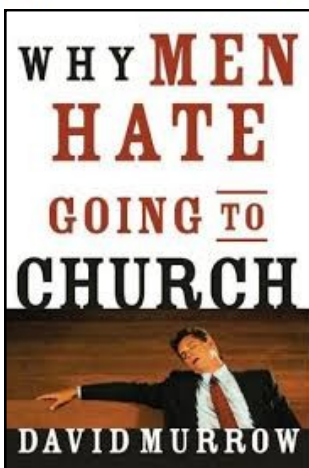

We are continuing to learn about Moses. Today was the part that most kids (and adults) find fascinating—the plagues! To remind you, God told Moses to go to Pharaoh and tell him to let the Israelites go so they could serve Him. Pharaoh didn't want to let the people go because they were doing a lot of work for him! Also, he didn't know the God of Moses and certainly wasn't going to sacrifice the slaves for this so-called God.

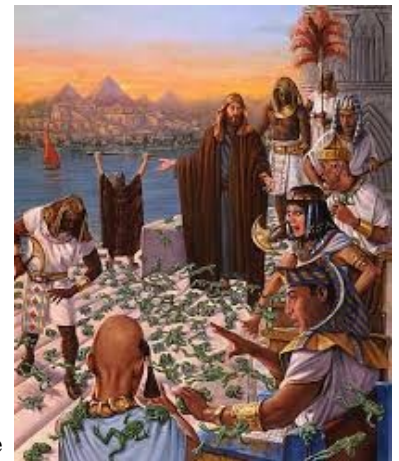
To prove He was "I AM", God told Moses to tell Aaron to throw his staff down. It turned into a snake! Well, Pharaoh was more stubborn than a two-year-old! He still wasn't

convinced this God was more powerful than he was. Read Exodus 7:17-21 to see what happened next!

Pharaoh still wouldn't let the people go. Ask your child if they can remember the plagues that God sent next. Fyi, they were **frogs, gnats, flies, death of livestock, leprosy, hail, grasshoppers, darkness, and finally, the death of the firstborn.**

Devastated, Pharaoh finally let God's people go. You might remember that this story is far from over. We'll continue next week in Children's Church.

## What will we do in Missionz Kidz?

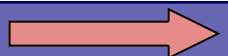
